#### Equipment:

The rooms in the department of Education (SR 1, 4, 5, 6, 7; HS 1; Medien- & Methodenlabor) are equipped with a computer, beamer, whiteboard and flipchart as well as camera/microphone for hybrid teaching.

### In the media console you will find:

- HDMI-Cable
- VGA-Cable
- Audio-Cable

#### Instruction manual:

To activate the beamer, press the **"Display ON"** button on the key panel. Also make sure that the **"PC"** button is also selected.

If you want to project content from a laptop, you must first connect the laptop to the AV console using an HDMI cable. In addition, the **"HDMI"** button must be selected.

 $\rightarrow$  If the button lights up read, this indicates the active setting.
